ATHOME MOOC

The Athome MOOC is a tool created within the framework of the "Athome" project, which aims to enable home helpers to validate a European reference system of both technical and transversal skills.

Description of the tool

Resulting from the collaborative culture of social learning, which promotes the sharing of everyone's knowledge for the benefit of everyone's skills, the ATHOME project decompartmentalises the sectors : professional training, higher education, associations. Paramedical and social students, teachers and researchers have collaborated with home helpers, job seekers, trainers and trainees to create this training, as close as possible to the reality and the needs of these professions.

Thanks to this training, you will be able to validate a base of 12 transversal skills, suggested in the European [AEFA skills reference framework](#).

Use of the tool

The Athome MOOC is divided into 2 parts:

- 7 skills that you can work on online on your computer independently. In each skill you will find several lessons of different levels followed by quizzes to validate your learning
- The 5 other skills require coaching or team work and are covered in a series of tutorials designed for trainers.
